#### **Treasurer's Report:**

Mary Wolfe reported we are financially in good shape. From our January-June budget, we spent \$200 less than was budgeted. Our total assets to date are: \$141,084.44.

## <u>Architecture/Landscape Report</u>:

Larry Shadle reported the grass area for the path to the mailbox on Del Monte has been dug out. Gravel will be added for the pathway. Jaime will repair the sprinkler issue on Del Monte tomorrow.

Larry received a \$775 quote from Jaime to plant Spira Anthony shrubs, rake and add topsoil to the area on Del Monte next to Katie Howe's place.

Concrete work is being done for Linda McClain, Tere Bippes and Musa Wolcott this week.

Linda McClain requested installation of two retractable awnings. She will need to get approval from the CCC.

### **Welcome Committee:**

Nan Moon reported it has been quiet with no activity. A family member will be moving into Peter Clarkson's Place.

#### **Emergency Preparedness:**

Sandy Batte reported the statistic from AARP is: 'In the US by 2035, there will be more people over the age of 65 than people under the age of 18'. Two other interesting stats were:

- "On average, older Americans live 90 minutes from family help."
- "Older adults outlive their ability to drive between 7-10 years, which becomes a huge issue when we talk about evacuation orders."

In the event of an emergency, transportation out of Charbonneau could be a problem. We will be working with SpringRidge regarding this issue. Our 'First Responders' will be overwhelmed and we will be on our own.
